CALL FOR SHORT PAPERS AND RESEARCH ARTICLES

Participants

- Short Essays: Senior high school or vocational high school students (individuals or teams of up to 3, with at least one supervising teacher).
- Research Papers: Undergraduate, master's, and doctoral students.

Topics

Open to all topics, but submissions must focus on resources archived in the National Library of Taiwan's "Taiwan Memory" system (e.g., folk culture, local history, social development).

Submission

Complete the registration form at the submission link below and upload:

1. Manuscript (PDF format)
2. Identification documents (front and back of your student ID, which must verify enrollment for the current academic year.)
3. Deadline: October 1, 2025

Format

- Short Essays: The manuscript should be 4 to 10 pages in length on A4 paper (including appendices but excluding the cover page).
- Research Papers: Chinese $\leq 15,000$ words, English $\leq 8,000$ words, APA style.

Evaluation

- Short Essays: Significance & completeness 40%, Resource application 20%, Creativity 25%, Practicality 15%
- Research Papers: Double-blind peer review; assessed for academic value, topic contribution, and argument quality

Awards

- Short Essays: Top Prize (2) – NT\$10,000 + certificate; Excellence (5) – NT\$5,000 + certificate; Merit (8) – NT\$3,000 + certificate
- Research Papers: 10 selected, NT\$10,000 + certificate; published in National Library Journal

Results & Ceremony

- Short Essays: Announced November 2025 on the National Library website, Facebook, and Taiwan Memory homepage
- Research Papers: Individual notification
- Award Ceremony & Presentations: November–December 2025 at the National Library
